## INTRODUCTION

Pinpoint works on Nokia Series 60 3<sup>rd</sup> edition phones with either an internal GPS receiver or an external Bluetooth GPS receiver. We expect Nokia to release many new phones with internal GPS, so please check the Assist Abroad website for up to date information.

### What you will need

You will need one of the following Nokia phones configured to allow internet browsing.

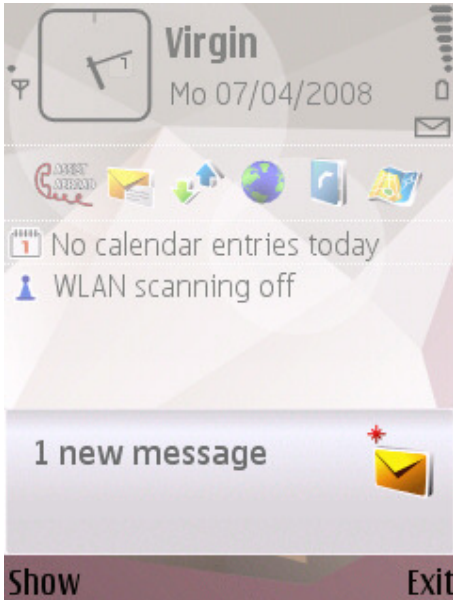

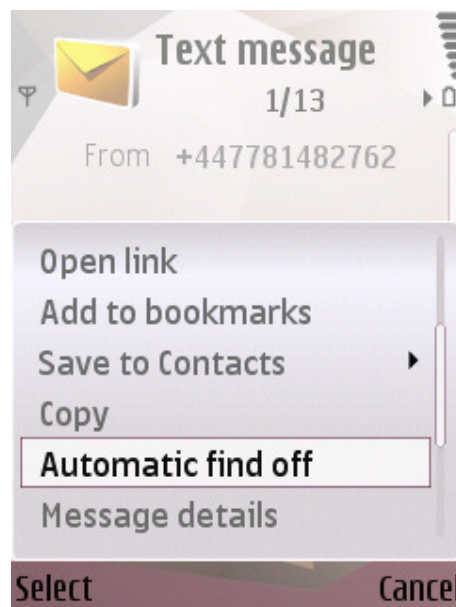
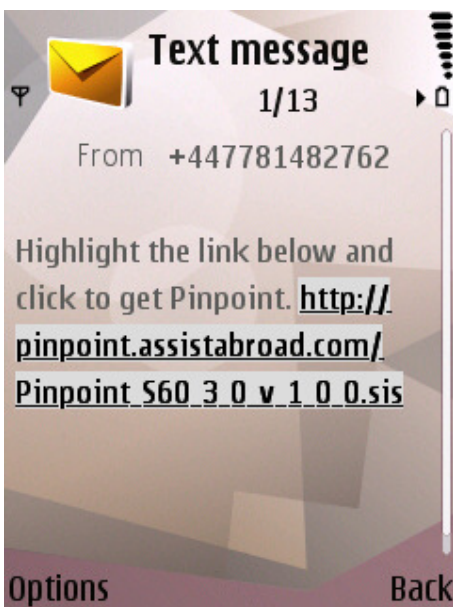


## Step 1

Send a SMS text message with **PP** in the message body to **07781481508** or **+447781481508**. After a short while Assist Abroad will send you a text message containing a download link to the Pinpoint application.



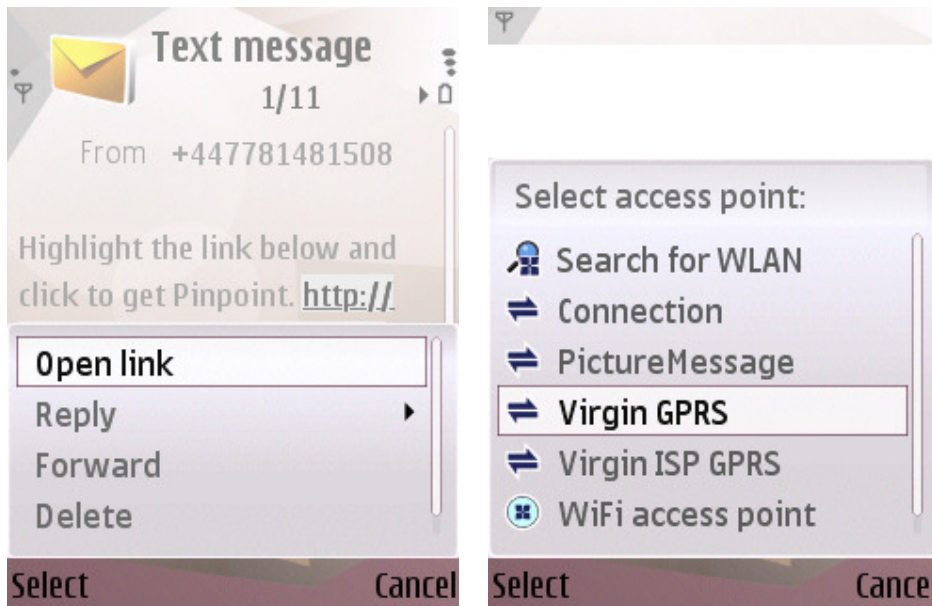
View the text message by pressing the **Show** button and then highlight the download link by using the down scroll key to highlight [http://pinpoint.assistabroad.com/Pinpoint\\_S60\\_3\\_0\\_v\\_1\\_0\\_0.sis](http://pinpoint.assistabroad.com/Pinpoint_S60_3_0_v_1_0_0.sis) link then “select” (centre button). If you do not see the link highlighted as illustrated below, press the “options” key and check the setting of “Automatic find”. Make sure it shows “off”.





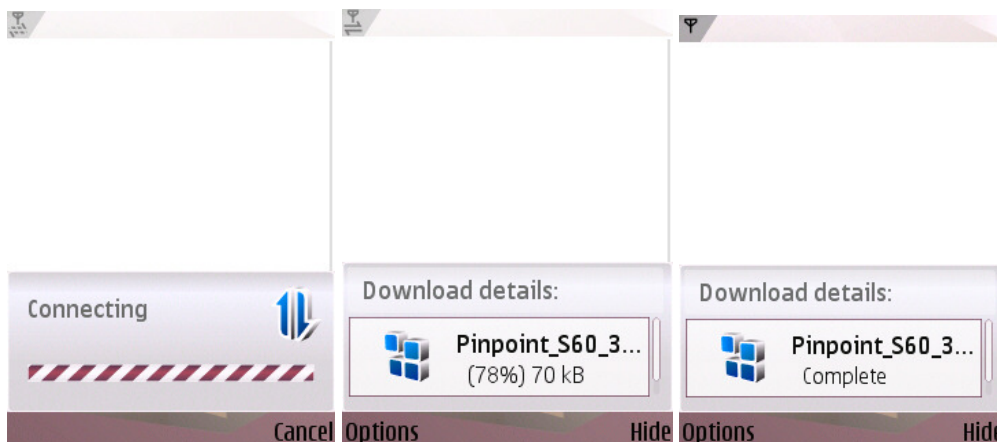
## Step 2

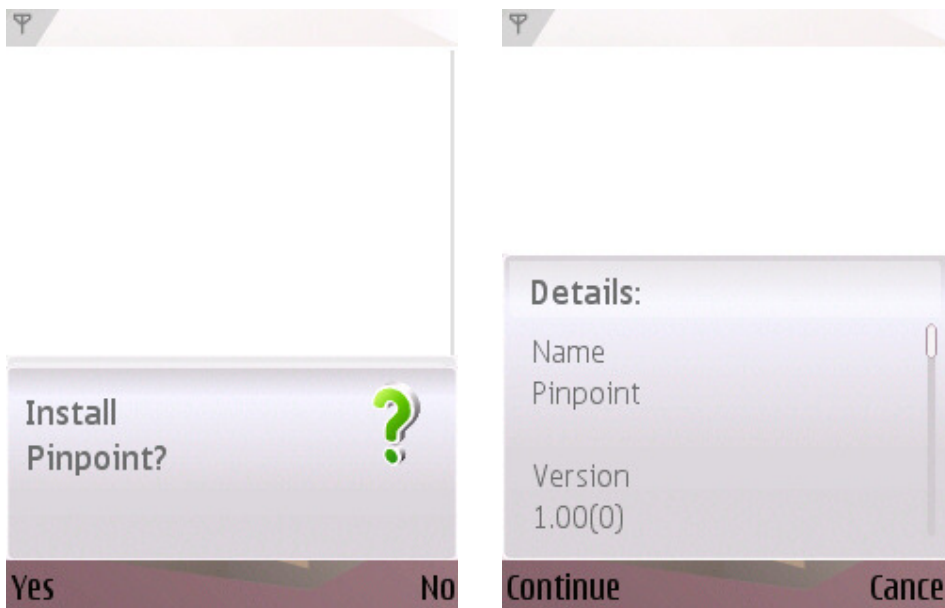
Select **Open link** then select an “access point”. If your phone has wireless LAN support (WiFi) then use this in preference to GPRS or Internet access point. GPRS and internet access points should have been configured by your mobile network operator. Please note that data charges may apply when downloading Pinpoint using GPRS.



## Step 3

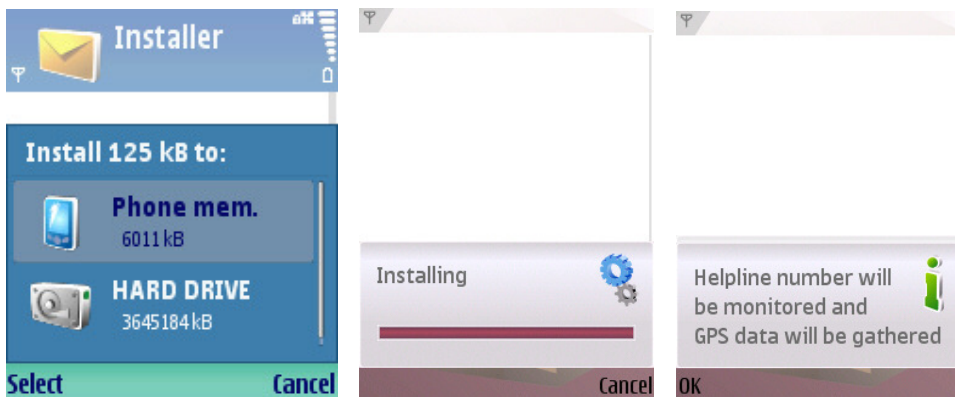
When the download is complete you will be asked to confirm whether to install Pinpoint. Confirm by pressing **Yes** then press **Continue**





#### Step 4

During Pinpoint installation you may be asked to select whether to install in phone memory or on a memory card. Select **Phone memory**. After Pinpoint has installed you are informed that Pinpoint will monitor for the dialling of the Assist Abroad helpline number and periodically acquire your GPS position.



Nokia phones without GPS will require “pairing” with an external Bluetooth GPS receiver. Please refer to Appendix A for further instructions.

#### Step 5

The final step is to register on the Assist Abroad website. If you are already an Assist Abroad member, you can bypass this step by pressing the **Close** button.

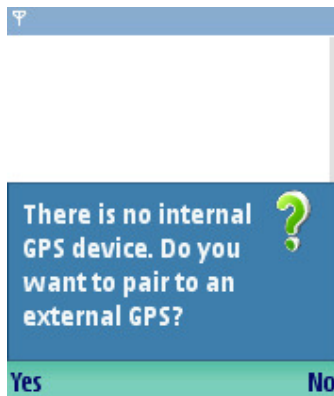

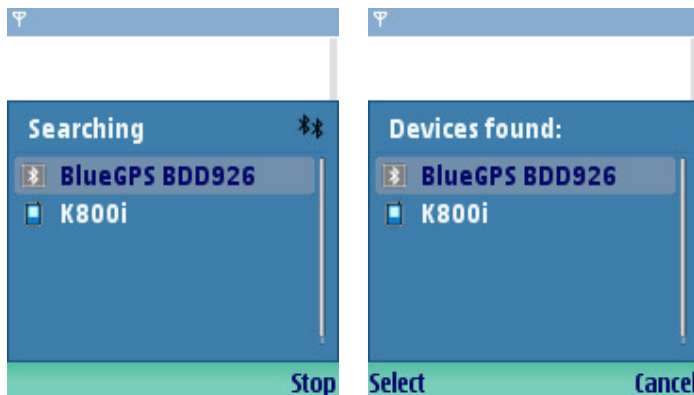
## APPENDIX A

### Instructions on connecting an external GPS receiver

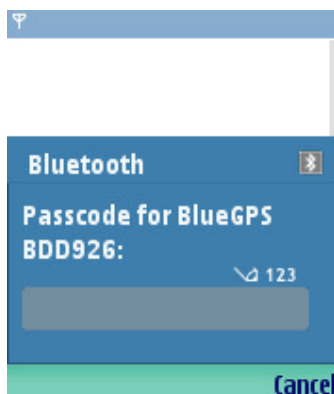
If your phone does not have an internal GPS receiver you will see a message asking if you wish to “pair” to an external GPS receiver during installation. Make sure that your Bluetooth GPS receiver is switched on and within range of your phone.



Press the **Yes** key and your phone will start searching for Bluetooth devices.



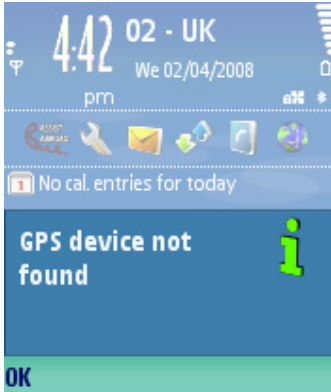
After a short while, any Bluetooth devices found will be shown. Note that the name of your GPS device will differ from the example shown. Highlight your Bluetooth GPS device and press the **Select** key.





You will normally be asked for a “passcode”. Check your GPS receiver documentation for this. Most devices use the passcode 0000 (zero- zero- zero- zero). Enter your passcode to complete the “pairing” process.

If during normal phone use you see a message “GPS device is not found” it normally means your Bluetooth GPS receiver is switched off or out of Bluetooth range.





## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q.** Why can I not highlight the link in the download text message?

**A.** Make sure “Automatic Find” is turned on. While viewing the text message press **Options** and scroll down the options list to **Automatic find**. This option toggles between **off** and **on**. Make sure the **Options** list is set to **Automatic find off**.
